Online Courses Have Landed @BRCC!



The nation's first & only Federal Aviation Administration-approved Airframe and Powerplant online courses are now available through **Blue Ridge Community College in Virginia!** BRCC's Aviation Maintenance Technology program is excited to offer this distance learning opportunity, in a dynamic and high-demand career field.

Graduates of the Aviation Maintenance Technology (AMT) program are eligible to take the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Written, Oral, and Practical exams for a Mechanic's Certificate with Airframe and Powerplant ratings. BRCC graduates have a 100% pass rate on the certification exams.

This is a selective program with only 25 spaces, and classes begin October 17. Financial aid may be available for qualified applicants. The program may be a good career fit for individuals with military experience and those with some background in the aviation field.

BRCC's Aviation Maintenance Technology Distance Education program is fully approved by the Federal Aviation Administration.

The BRCC Distance AMT program is part of an FAA Beta Test and takes place online. Additional AMT classes required for the certificate and/or A.A.S. degree will be held at the BRCC Shenandoah Valley Regional Airport facility. While this is a Beta Test and initially limited to certain courses, it is anticipated that additional courses will be added upon successful completion of the Beta Test.
