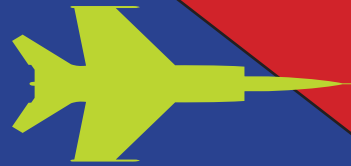


Application Checklist

- Be reimbursed for Teaching!

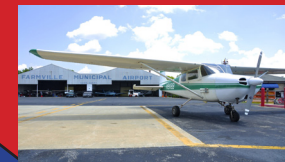
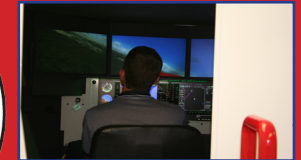

Applications for the 2018/19 school year are eligible from August 1st to May 31st. Qualifying applications will be evaluated on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Ideas could include:

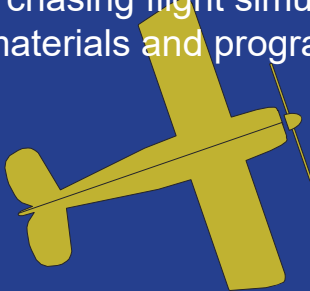
Using grant money to purchase wood and building materials for model airplanes

Eligible grant applications will be funded until this cap has been reached. Funds must be used before the end of the school year in which they are approved. The requirements listed must be met in order to apply, be selected, and be reimbursed. A grant agreement will be sent to those selected.

Describe your aviation lesson idea. What will you be teaching and what facets of aviation or aerospace do you plan to use to teach it? (150-500 words).

What learning outcomes are you looking for from this project?

If funded, how do you propose to share this lesson with your colleagues?

For what will the grant be used? Write a plan for how you will spend the funds on aviation-related projects.

I agree that before the end of the school year in which I receive this grant, I will complete the project described. I will provide a final report of the program to include all of the following:

- Copies of lesson plans developed, including Virginia SOLs met.
- A copy of at least one lesson plan.
- A summary of the results of the program and suggested modifications for future use.
- Number of students who benefited from the program.
- A shopping list of materials and cost for supplies.
- Receipts for supplies purchased for the program.

I understand that the Virginia Department of Aviation will reimburse only those amounts approved in the original grant and a reimbursement check will be prepared only upon receipt of the final report. I will also need to turn in a completed Commonwealth W-9 form to get the reimbursement. (Taxpayer identification number needed).

I further understand that the Virginia Department of Aviation may publish lesson plans and program summaries in its aviation education publications (with credit given).
