PERMITTED

- Watercolor • Colored Pencils • Acrylic • Oil Paint • Indelible Marker Pens • Felt-Tip or Soft Ball-Point Pens • Indelible Ink • Crayons

NOT PERMITTED

- Pencil, charcoal or other non-permanent medium
- Computer-generated artwork
- Collage work involving the use of photos
