#### FY2020 Reporting

#### **Revised Statewide Report**

In accordance with Code of Virginia §5.1-2.2:4 Transparency and accountability for use of Department (DOAV) and Virginia Aviation Board (VAB) funds, by August 1 of each year, sponsors that have received or disbursed funds from any of the state's aviation funding programs within the prior fiscal year shall submit to DOAV a report detailing the purpose for which such funds were received or disbursed. The report shall also list any localities from which such entity received funds.

This reporting is to include projects funded under the Airport Capital Program, the Facilities and Equipment Program, the Voluntary Security Program, the Maintenance Program, the Rural Airport Program, and the Aviation and Airport Promotion Program. To assist sponsors with this reporting, DOAV created an Excel spreadsheet form, *Annual Self-Reporting of State Aviation Funding Received*, to be completed and electronically submitted by sponsors.

For the commercial service airports, the submission of the FY2020 *Entitlement Utilization Report* satisfied the requirement for reporting the receipt of state entitlement funds. If a commercial service airport sponsor received any Commonwealth Airport Fund discretionary, maintenance, or promotional funds, the sponsor reported those using the spreadsheet.

If a sponsor did not received any state funding during FY2020, the sponsor so indicated by checking a statement that reads "The sponsor did not receive any state aviation funds during FY2020".

The reports submitted by the sponsors are provided on the following pages. These reports have been reconciled to DOAV's funding data. The entitlement utilization reports included in the August 2020 statewide report have not been approved by the Virginia Aviation Board, as the board is not scheduled to meet until mid-September. After the meeting, the approved reports will be added to the statewide report, and the revised statewide report will be posted on the agency website.

Since the original compilation of the statewide report, reconciled reports have been received for Chase City Municipal Airport and Suffolk Executive Airport. Reconciled reports for the following airports had not submitted at the time this statewide report was prepared:

1	This project is for maintenance and repair of eligible Airport equipment that arises in FY21. Approval will be sought from DOAV staff at the time each need arises
2	This project is for purchase of eligible Airport equipment as the need arises in FY21. Approval will be sough from DOAV staff at the time each need arises.
3	This project is for maintenance and repair of eligible Airport facilities that arises in FY21. Approval will be sought from DOAV staff at the time each need arises.
4	This project is for repair and/or rehabilitation of eligible Airport pavements that arises in FY21. Approval will be sought from DOAV staff at the time each need arises.
5	Pavement markings deteriorate over time and require re-marking. This project will maintain our existing markings to standards along with allowing us to install new markings as the need may arise on airport property. Approval will be sought from DOAV staff at the time each need arises.
6	A new Air Traffic Control Tower (ATCT) was completed in June 2017 with all tower radio and other related equipment provided by the Airport as part of the required FAA contract tower minimum equipment list. The equipment is no longer under warranty and requires service contracts in FY21 in order to provide the necessary preventive maintenance and upkeep of various equipment and systems.
7	The Airport is estimating \$7,500 for an annual service agreement to provide and maintain a "Multi User Flight Information Display Sysyem" (MUFIDS). This system is directly related to providing passengers with up to date air carrier flight information in the passenger terminal.
8	Lynchburg Regional Airport maintains over 500 acres on the AOA and around the airport terminal. Much of this land is hilly with slopes exceeding the safety limits of traditional mowing tractors. We would like to purchase a tractor and appropriate accessories to allow operations personnel to safely mow these areas on the airport.
9	Lynchburg Regional Airport has an airport security perimeter which includes fencing with 50 gates. Perimeter gates currently have master style locks which do not allow an audit trail in the event of a security incident. Also individual users all have to provide their own locks and keys leaving some areas with multiple locks on one access point. We would like to upgrade the existing system to locks and keys that provide an audit trail. These improvements will allow the keys and locks to be uniquely programmed with a user's access level so only one lock will be needed on each access point.
10	The most recent estimate of likely cost for this project as estimated by the RS&H Aviation Architect dated April 9, 2020, put the total cost in the neighborhood of \$2,000,000 (which is an increase of \$800,000 over the \$1,200,000 amount approved in our FY2020 Plan.
